

Application for Free 3-week Summer Activities for Newcomers in Reykjavík Youth Centres

According to regulations in Leisure and Youth Centres, newcomers can apply for a free 3-week summer activities in Reykjavík Leisure and Youth Centres if the following conditions are fulfilled:

If parents are of foreign origin and their legal address is in Reykjavík (either or both parents), and if their child has been living in Iceland for less than two years, they can apply for a free 3-week long summer activities for their child at a leisure centre, special summer programme or youth centre. This offer does not apply to children whose legal address is abroad and who only come here temporarily during the summer months. This offer is provided, and only if the conditions are fulfilled, to the parent that has the same legal address as the child according to the National Registry.

Parents can apply for summer activities on the website http://sumar.fristund.is, and must also fill out this form to the director of the leisure centre, special summer programme or youth centre.
