


Viðmið vegna inntöku nemenda í Skólahljómsveitir Reykjavíkur

Þegar teknir eru inn nemendur í Skólahljómsveitir borgarinnar
er stuðst við eftifarandi viðmið:

- Nemendur sem eru í hljómsveitinni og ætla að halda áfram ganga fyrir.
- Umsóknir sem berast fyrir 30.maí njóta forgangs.
- Umsóknir sem berast eftir 30. maí verða teknar til umfjöllunar áður en starfið hefst.
- Lágmarksaldur nemenda við inntöku í skólahljómsveitir er 8 ár eða 3. bekkur.
- Hafi nemandi verið á biðlista eru meiri líkur á að hann fái pláss í hljómsveit.
- Skólahljómsveitirnar eru fjórar: Skólahljómsveit Austurbæjar, Skólahljómsveit Árbæjar og Breiðholts, Skólahljómsveit Grafarvogs og Skólahljómsveit Vesturbæjar og Miðborgar. Hver hljómsveit þjónar afmörkuðu hverfi. Umsóknir sem koma úr hverfi hljómsveitarinnar ganga fyrir.
- Umsóknir nemenda sem eru í 4. bekk ganga að jafnaði fyrir
- Nemendur sem koma úr tónlsitarnámi annars staðar, t.d. öðrum skólahljómsveitum eða öðrum tónlistarskólum, geta gengið fyrir inn í námið en sú afgreiðsla er háð ákvörðun stjórnanda hverju sinni.
- Það getur skipt máli hvaða hljóðfæri er sótt um. Flókin samsetning skólahljómsveita, staðsetning kennara í skólum og á hvaða hljóðfæri viðkomandi kennari kennir, hefur áhrif á inntöku nýrra nemenda.
- Framboð hljóðfæra í einstökum skólum getur verið breytilegt milli ára.





The principal objective of the School Concert Bands in Reykjavík is to promote the musical competence, knowledge, and development of students through orchestral activities and support the musical education of their students in collaboration with the school.

School Concert Bands in Reykjavík – Applications for school year 2025 – 26

Electronic applications for enrolment in the four School Concert Bands in Reykjavík will be opened at 9:00 on Monday, April 1st. Please access the application form on the Reykjavík website. The formal deadline for applications is May 30th for the school year 2024 -25, but applications can be submitted after that if parents/guardians want the child 's name to be on the waiting list.

Admission to the School Concert Bands is based on the time of the application, as well as the availability of the instrument that is applied for in the child 's school. See criteria for admission to the School Concert Bands here below. It is possible to make comments in the application form about previous education in music, previous applications etc. Those who already have tried to apply for the School Concert Band are asked to repeat the application for the coming school year.

All major brass and woodwind instruments are taught in the School Concert Bands as well as percussion instruments and electric bass. It is possible to rent instruments from the School Concert Bands. Tuition fees are according to the applicable tariff at any given time.

An ambitious instrumental education

An ambitious instrumental education is offered in the School Concert Bands with well-educated and experienced teachers. The program is based on the national curriculum of the music schools.



Focus on playing in the band – obligatory participation

The main emphasis of the studies is to play in the concert band. Full commitment and participation is required from the students by being active both in practices as in concerts. Students receive training in playing their instrument in private lessons.

Student Admission Criteria for School Concert Bands in Reykjavik

Enrolment in the school concert bands is based on the following criteria:

- Students who are already enrolled in the school concert bands and intend to renew their application.
- Applications received before May 30th are prioritized.
- Applications received after May 30th will be considered due to availability.
- The minimum age for entering school concert bands is 8 years or 3rd grade.
- If a student has been on the waiting list, it is more likely that he/she/they will get a place in the band.
- The four school concert bands in Reykjavik are: Skólahljómsveit Austurbæjar, Skólahljómsveit Árbæjar og Breiðholts, Skólahljómsveit Grafarvogs and Skólahljómsveit Vesturbæjar og Miðborgar. Each band serves a defined neighborhood. Applications from the neighborhood of the bands have priority.
- Applications from students in the 4th grade usually have priority.
- Students who have studied music elsewhere e.g. in other school concert bands or music schools can enter the program. It is though subject to the director's decision at any given time.
- The composition of the school concert bands, the location of the teachers in the schools and the instruments the teacher is teaching can have an impact on acceptance of new students.
- The availability of musical instruments in individual schools can vary between years.



Kryteria przyjmowania uczniów do Orkiestr Szkolnych Miasta Reykjavík

- Uczniowie, którzy są w orkiestrze i zamierzają kontynuować, przyjmowani są w pierwszej kolejności
- Pierwszeństwo przyznaje się wnioskom, które wpłyną przed 15 maja.
- Wnioski otrzymane po 15 maja będą rozpatrywane przed rozpoczęciem prac.
- Minimalny wiek uczniów to 8 lat lub 3. klasa.
- Jeśli student był na liście oczekujących z poprzedniego roku, to jest większe prawdopodobieństwo, że otrzyma miejsce w orkiestrze.
- Dostępne są cztery szkoły: Szkolna orkiestra Austurbæjar, Szkolna orkiestra Árbæjar, Szkolna orkiestra Grafarvogur i Szkolna orkiestra Vesturbæjar. Każda ze szkół przyjmuje uczniów z określonej dzielnicy. Wnioski pochodzące z dzielnicy szkoły są ważne.
- Wnioski uczniów w 4. klasie są zazwyczaj rozpatrywane
- Uczniowie, którzy pochodzą z innych szkół, np. z innych regionów, mogą zostać przyjęte, ale decyzja jest zależna od decyzji dyrektora.
- Czynnikiem decydującym o przyjęciu, może być wybrany instrument. Skład orkiestry, lokalizacja nauczycieli w szkołach oraz instrument, którego naucza.
- Dostępność instrumentów w poszczególnych szkołach może być różna w zależności od roku.
