


Population in Reykjavik by gender & age 2020










Women and men chosen as Athlete of the Year by the Association of Sports Journalists (1956-2019)









Immigrants who participate in local sport clubs* between 6-18 years of age in Reykjavik, 2019





Participants between 6-18 years of age by gender in local sports clubs in Reykjavik, 2019




Chairmen of local sports clubs in Reykjavik by gender 2016 & 2020















Individuals issued an artist salary* by gender & art form 2020















Registered volunteers at the Reykjavik Red Cross by gender 2020






People registered for the welfare services back-up team by gender in April 2020





People registered for the welfare services back-up team by origin in April 2020




People registered for the health care services back-up team by gender in April 2020

People who have been tested for Covid-19 by the Health Care System & Decode by gender April 2020



Nursing school graduates from the University of Iceland by gender in 2009 & 2019








Number of police call-outs due to domestic violence for the first 4 months of 2019 & 2020


Reykjavik City call-outs* due to domestic violence during the first 4 months of 2019 & 2020 by gender of the victim








Relationship between the perpetrator and victim by gender for domestic violence calls attended by Reykjavik City January-March 2020


Reykjavík City call-outs due to domestic violence by citizenship and gender of victims and perpetrator January – March 2020

Domestic violence reports to Reykjavik Child Protection Services in the first 4 months of 2019 & 2020




Managing Directors of the Icelandic National Broadcasting Service from the beginning by gender (1930-2020)
